

Rules for Use of Nolte Island

The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) owns and operates the Nolte Island Park and graciously agreed to allow the Texas Lineman's Rodeo Association to use the park. The park is a pristine natural wildlife area and is home to many varieties of wildlife, including turkey, deer, birds, raccoons, skunks, snakes, insects, etc.

The GBRA has several specific rules that must be followed while on the island:

- 1) All illegal drugs or firearms are prohibited.
- 2) All glass containers are prohibited, including bottles.
- 3) Alcoholic beverages are permitted.
- 4) Dispose of all trash and empty containers in the appropriate refuse containers around the island.
- 5) Each campsite guest will be responsible for cleaning area prior to departure.
- 6) No dumping of septic or wastewater from campers, motor homes, or other means on the island (Restroom facilities are available).
- 7) All campers and rodeo equipment must be removed from the island by 5:00 pm on Sunday, July 20, 2008.
